2019 SCHOLARSHIP ANIMAL HOW IT WORKS

he Foundation Scholarship Animal Project is an annual scholarship program that assists well-rounded, high academic achievers in pursuit of their educational goals in the field of agriculture.

Ashlie Andrade was chosen from a large pool of applicants to raise and show the Foundation's Scholarship Animal at this year's Fair. The Scholarship Animal will be the last to be auctioned before the Grand Champions at the Junior Livestock Auction on Saturday, July 13, 2019. **Everyone has an opportunity to contirbute.** All proceeds from the sale will benefit the Foundation's efforts to improve the Fairgrounds and provide scholarships and educational opportunities for local youth. The Foundation Animal will be processed and donated to the local food bank.

Regarless of the proceeds from the sale, Ashlie is guaranteed to receive:

- \$3,000 College Scholarship
- \$2,500 Cash Prize



HELP ASHLIE GET MORE MONEY!

Ashlie is guaranteed to receive her scholarship package valued at \$5,500. But, the more you bid, the more Ashlie stands to earn in scholarship funds. Should the total proceeds from the sale of the scholarship animal exceed \$55,000, Ashlie will receive 10% of the proceeds in excess of \$55,000 in the form of additional scholarship funds.

HOW TO BID AT AUCTION

All registered buyers have an opportunity to bid on the Scholarship Animal. The auctioneer will start at \$50 per pound and will go as low as \$1 per pound.

Let's say Ashlie's goat weighs 100 pounds. A bid of: \$50/lb is a donation of \$5,000 \$25/lb is a donation of \$2,500 \$10/lb is a donation of \$1,000

\$5/lb is a donation of \$500
